**February 15 - 20, 2009**

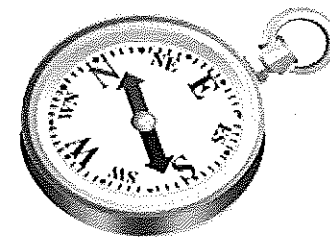
- Joshua 11
