5. If you were Eli, how would you have reacted to the Lord's words?
6. If you were Samuel, how would you have felt repeating them to Eli?
7. How did Eli know the voice of the Lord?
8. What did Samuel mean when he said, "Speak, for your servant is listening"?

Reflect

9. Do you pray with an attitude of: (a) "speak Lord, your servant listens" or (b) "listen Lord, for your servant speaks"?
10. How can you learn to listen more and speak less?
11. How do you treat the word of God?

Pray

12. Pray for your soul and ears to be receptive to what the Lord wants you to hear and act upon.
13. Pray that you will recognize the people, places, and occurrences the Lord presents you with, so that you may do his will.
14. Pray for the members of your group and their needs.
