9. Of the promises to Abram, which appeal to you and why? (Would you rather be blessed or a blessing).
10. To what (place, people, priority) might God be calling you? Why not go?
11. What sure promise are you questioning?

12. Pray for the courage to follow the path God has laid out before you.
13. Give thanks for the opportunities that the Lord will prepare for you to bless others and to honor him.
14. Pray for the members of your group and their needs.
