6. How does Jesus treat the demon-possessed man differently than the way others have?
7. Why do you think Jesus makes the sick woman reveal herself?
8. Why do you think Jesus tells some to be quiet about their healing and others to go home and tell everyone?

### Reflect

9. Compare your life to the weather. What's the forecast?
10. When you first "met" Jesus, how did he treat you? How was that different from the way others treat you?
11. When have you been as desperate as the sick woman? How did Jesus touch you then?

### Pray

12. Pray for courage to face the storms of life and give thanks for the hope and healing that is found through faith in Jesus.
13. Ask the Lord to prepare the way for you to share your story of how he has worked miracles in you and saved you.
14. Pray for the members of your group and their needs.
