9. What proofs do you have of Jesus' resurrection that would make sense to your non-believing friends?
10. Where is your "Jerusalem" to which you are called to bear witness?
11. How do you sense a need for the Spirit to help you?

12. Pray for the power of the Holy Spirit to lead you courageously in the path he has set before you.
13. Pray for those who do not know the Lord and that you can be used to disciple them.
14. Pray for the members of your group and their needs.
