8. What is the ultimate authority in your life? When does this create problems for you?
9. How would you feel if you were sent to jail for what you believe?
10. In what way has God set you free to honor him?

11. Pray for the spirit of joy when you are persecuted for sharing the truth of the Gospel.
12. Ask for strength, wisdom, and compassion when God allows you to go through hardships.
13. Pray for the members of your group and their needs.
