6. What does the contrasting seed and bush teach about the kingdom (vv. 30-32)?

Reflect

7. Does knowing the kingdom is ultimately in God's hands cause you to rest or work more? Why?
8. At what stage is the kingdom in your life now: Still a seed? Sprouting? Outgrowing the "weeds"? Producing a harvest?
9. Where have you seen kingdom growth from a seed to something much larger? Was it a ministry, an outreach, a discipling relationship or perhaps something else?

10. Pray for kingdom growth to continue to grow and bear fruit in your life.
11. Pray to be used by God to further the kingdom growth in your church, the community, and to areas of ministry that he has prepared you for.
12. Pray for the members of your group and their needs.
