Breaking the Ice

2. In taking on new work, do you "bite off more than you can chew"? Do you "chomp at the bit"? Why?

Digging In

3. Share the notes you took during the worship service. Did you learn anything new?
4. Read Exodus 3:1-12 and discuss.
5. Why do you think God used a burning bush to get Moses' attention?
6. What if He had simply begun speaking instead? What is the effect on Moses? What relationship has God initiated with Moses (vv.5-6)?
7. What does God ask Moses to do for Israel (vv.7-10)?
8. How does Moses reply? Is Moses more uncertain of himself or God?

Reflect

9. Recall an event when you felt like you were standing on "holy ground"? What was sacred about that moment?
10. What would God have to do to get your attention and commitment to take on a new mission in life?
11. How would you likely respond if God called you by name?

Pray

12. Pray that you will recognize the burning bush God is trying to use to get your attention.
13. Pray that excuses and fear will not prevent you from doing what God has already prepared you to be victorious in.
14. Pray for the members of your group and their needs.
