- Why do you think this man gave a different amount of talents to each of his servants? Regardless of the amount of their talents, what do you think the man expected the servants to do with their talents?
- What did the five-talent servant do with his talents? What did the two-talent servant do with his talents? What did the one-talent servant do?
- When the master returned, what did he say to the two servants who had used their talents wisely? How do you think this made them feel?
- What excuse did the one-talent servant give for his actions? Does his excuse make any sense? What did the master call this servant? What did the master do to this servant? How might this servant's actions be a *sin to confess*?
- What God-given talents or gifts do you have? In what ways are you currently using your talents and spiritual gifts for the Lord?
- When we are faithful to God with the little things He has given us, what did God say He would do? When we are unfaithful with what God has given us, what will He do? What does it mean "to enter into the joy of your Lord?"
- If Jesus were to return today, do you think you would hear Him say, "Well done My good and faithful servant?" Why or why not?

**Prayer:** Let's thank God today for the talents He has given us and pray that we will use them wisely for His glory.
