Discussion Questions:

- Who is the meanest person you have ever known? What do you think made this person so mean? How did this person affect your life?
- In our story, we are told about a man with an unclean spirit. What is an unclean spirit? What power did the unclean spirit have over this man's life? Why do you think this man lived among the tombs?
- What did the man with the unclean spirit do when he saw Jesus? How do you think he was able to do this? Why do you think he did this?
- What did the unclean spirit know about Jesus that many people did not know? What did the unclean spirit ask Jesus not to do to him? What was the spirit's name and what did his name mean?
- Why do you think Jesus allowed the unclean spirits to go into the swine? What happened to those demon possessed swine? What lesson can we learn from this about Satan and his demons?
- How is the man described after he was set free from the unclean spirit? What does this teach us about the power of Jesus to change lives? What do you believe about "unclean spirits" and demon possession today?
- Perhaps we all battle with demons more than we realize. Are there any particular demons you've been battling with lately? How can we help?
- What did this man do after Jesus saved him? How is this *an example for us to follow*? What are some of the great things Jesus has done for you?
